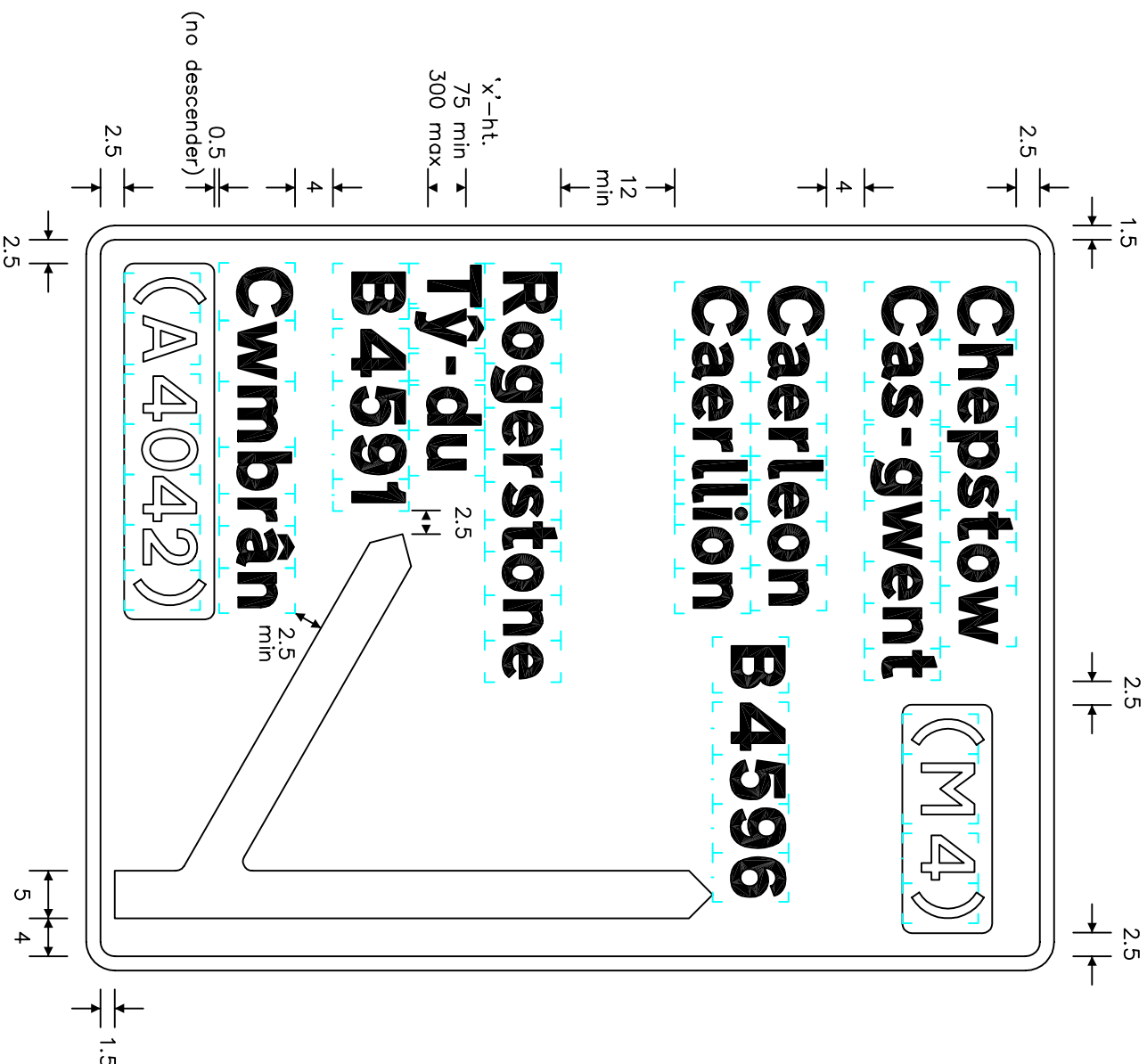
Motorway patch: -
