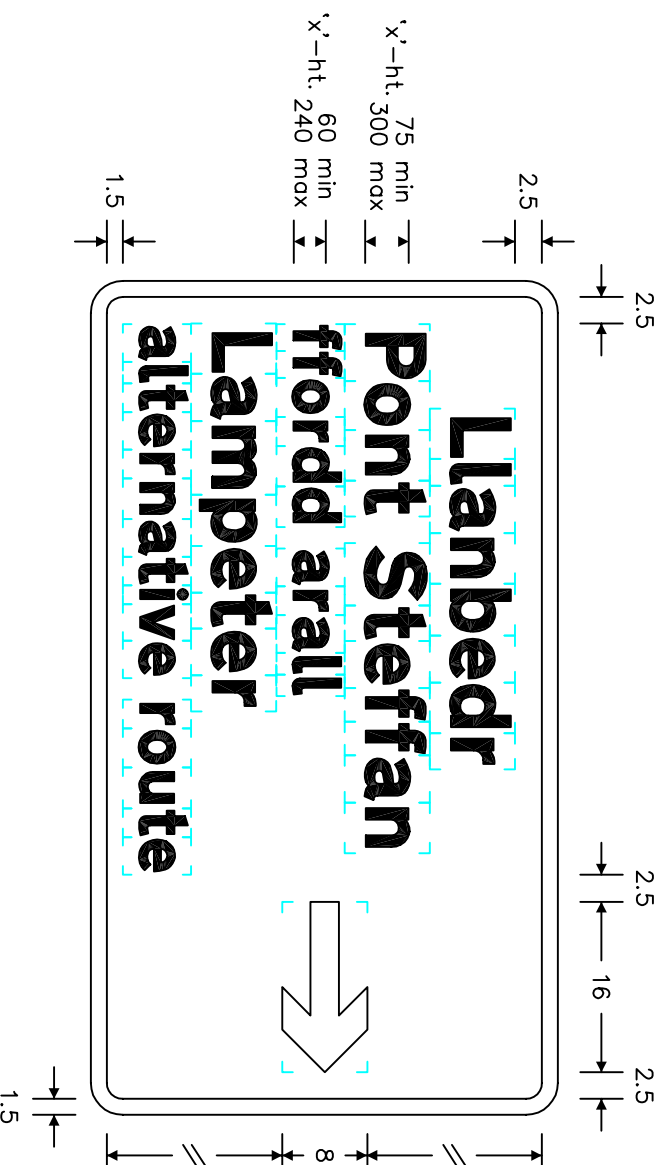


## Notes:-

1. The legend is from the Transport Heavy Alphabet at the 'x'-heights shown.
2. The outlines of the tiles do not form part of the sign.
3. The colours are as follows:-  
Background \_\_\_\_\_ White  
Legend, border, \_\_\_\_\_ Black  
& arrow \_\_\_\_\_ Black
4. The illumination of the sign must accord with the requirements of the current 'Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions'.
5. The 'x'-heights shown are given in millimetres, all other dimensions are given in stroke widths based on the placename 'x'-ht. (i.e.  $1s/w = 1/4 \times \text{height}$ )
6. The sign is designed in accordance with the current design rules.
7. The order of languages may be reversed if required.
